Full and half braces are available in 2 material thicknesses (0.1 and 0.15 mm). Depending on the size of the brace, it varies in width (2 or 3 mm). The full and half braces already have defined ends, so no cutting is required. This ensures that the gold plating continues right to the ends for maximum anti-inflammatory properties, while the rounded shape ensures minimum discomfort.

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SUCK

The GOLDSTADT professional is made of spring steel 1.4310 (chrome-nickel steel), which is widely used in the medical technology sector and especially in the dental sector. The steel has a gold plating. The brace is available in three different shapes, each in 5 sizes and different material thicknesses.

1.1 GOLDSTADT professional full brace

The "size" unit helps the user to select the brace. With the help of the RUCK NAIL CORRECTION measuring tool (item no: 2351701), the user can determine the nail width in millimetres. To securely attach a full brace, the nail width in millimetres, plus an allowance for the end hooks, is required. The smaller sizes are less wide so that the forces of the spring steel correspond to the nature of the nail.

1.2 GOLDSTADT professional half brace

The "size" unit helps the user to select the brace. With the help of the RUCK NAIL CORRECTION measuring tool (item no: 2351701), the user can determine the nail width in millimetres. To attach a half brace securely, an allowance is required for the end hook. If a shorter half brace is selected, the force on the suspended side is increased. The smaller sizes are less wide so that the forces of the spring steel correspond to the nature of the nail.

1.3 GOLDSTADT professional adhesive brace

The "size" unit helps the user to select the brace. With the help of the RUCK NAIL CORRECTION measuring tool (item no: 2351701), the user can determine the nail width in millimetres. The adhesive brace should be at least 1 mm away from the nail fold.

2 Intended purpose

The GOLDSTADT professional nail corrective brace has various applications. It is intended for the treatment of chronic nail deformities, ingrown nail tips, cornifications and pressure points in the nail area.

The brace must not be used in case of intolerance to the brace material.

The brace is a single-use product and is supplied non-sterile. A disposable product cannot be reused or resterilised. Moving the brace after the initial treatment (same patient and nail) is considered a continuation of the original treatment.

Initial treatment (disinfection/sterilisation) of the brace is possible. Depending on the skin status and the situation in which it is used, the user must decide whether treatment is necessary before use. 4 Area of use, duration of use

The circle of users includes podiatrists, chiropodists, doctors or related professional groups who are familiar with the application and have the necessary expertise.



In accordance with MDR 2017/745/EU class 1, the GOLDSTADT professional nail corrective brace is a non-invasive product intended for continuous use under normal conditions for a period of up to 28 days. A follow-up check must be carried out after this time. If the user does not recognise any risks, the duration of use can be extended and the product is classified as a Class 1 medical device in accordance with Rule 1 of Annex IX.

The GOLDSTADT professional brace is not intended to be combined with other products.





6 Patient and user protection

6.1 Potential risks for the patient

6.1.1 Risk of skin irritation/injury/inflammation and pain in the area around the nail

Choosing the right brace size and fitting and putting on the brace correctly are important prerequisites for avoiding skin irritation, skin injuries, pain and inflammation. The reactions usually occur rapidly and are quickly noticed by the patient and user. Countermeasures must be taken immediately.

6.1.2 Allergy risks

An allergic reaction of the patient to components of the brace or the adhesive cannot be ruled out. The brace is made of gold-plated spring steel. Both gold and spring steel, which is often used in medicine, have a low allergenic potential. The spring steel contains chromium and nickel. Components of the adhesive can lead to an allergic reaction in patients with an allergic tendency. A potential allergic reaction will usually be limited to local skin irritation.

6.1.3 Danger due to detachment of the nail

The selection of the correct brace size and the correct placement of the brace are important prerequisites for preventing the nail from detaching.

6.1.4 Risk of unintentional detachment of the brace

Insufficient preparation of the nail plate, inadequate fixation of the brace or incorrect positioning can lead to the brace coming off.



6.1.5 Potential infection of the nail

Infection of the nail plate due to excessive tension/activity of the brace, previous damage to the nail or lack of hygiene can lead to nail mycosis. Patient education should include necessary hygiene measures to prevent infection.

6.2 Potential risks for the user

If used as intended and protective equipment is worn, there are no risks for the user. The minimum protective equipment consists of a face mask and disposable gloves.
